Finished quilt size: 40½" x 56½"

Fabric Requirements

- 1 panel ($\frac{2}{3}$ yard) Plume-CM6458 Sage
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard Plume-CM6459 Latte
- $\frac{1}{2}$ yard Plume-CM6590 Pacific
- $\frac{1}{8}$ yard Plume-CM6461 Sand
- $\frac{1}{8}$ yard Plume-CM6461 Sage
- $\frac{1}{8}$ yard Shimmer-Fern
- $1\frac{1}{8}$ yards Shimmer-Ocean (including $\frac{1}{2}$ yard for binding)
- $2\frac{2}{3}$ yards Plume backing of your choice
- 49" x 65" batting

Cutting

From Plume-CM6458 Sage:

- Trim the panel to 23" x 40".

From Plume-CM6459 Latte:

- Cut two $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x width-of-fabric (WOF) strips. Sub-cut two $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 40" side inner borders.
- Cut two $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut two $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $28\frac{1}{2}$ " top/bottom inner borders.

From Plume-CM6590 Pacific:

- Cut three $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut twenty $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From Plume-CM6461 Sand:

- Cut two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From Plume-CM6461 Sage:

- Cut two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut forty $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From Shimmer-Fern:

- Cut four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From Shimmer-Ocean:

- Cut ten $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Set five aside for binding. Set the remaining five aside for the outer border.
- Cut three $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut into twenty $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, sixteen $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles, four $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Block Construction

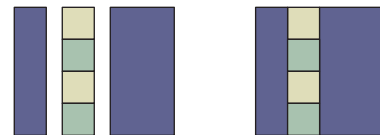
All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}$ " and pieces are sewn right sides together.

Pieced Blocks

Follow Figure 1 for construction.

- Using two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " CM6461 Sage squares and two $1\frac{1}{2}$ " CM6461 Sand squares, sew a four-block unit alternating colors.
- With a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " CM6461 Sand square in the top position, sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Shimmer-Ocean strip to the left side of the strip. Sew a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Shimmer-Ocean rectangle to the right side of the strip. Make a total of sixteen Pieced Blocks.

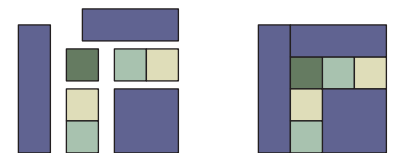
Corner Blocks

Follow Figure 2 for construction.

- Sew together a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " CM6461 Sage square and a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " CM6461 Sand square. Make two two-block units. With the CM6461 Sage block on the left, sew a two-block unit to the top of one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Shimmer-Ocean square.
- Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Shimmer-Fern square to the CM6461 Sand end of the remaining Sand/Sage two-block unit. Sew the three-block unit with the Shimmer-Fern end at the top to the left side of the pieced block.
- Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Shimmer-Ocean strip to the top of the block. Sew a $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Shimmer-Ocean strip to the left side of the pieced block.

Make a total of four Corner Blocks.

Quilt Top Assembly

Use the quilt photo as a guide for assembly, noting the orientation of blocks and directional prints.

6. Sew one 3¹/₄" x 40" CM6459 Latte strip to each side of the CM6458 Sage panel. Sew one 2³/₄" x 28¹/₂" CM6459 Latte to the top and the other to the bottom.
7. Sew together six 4¹/₂" CM6590 Pacific squares and five pieced squares alternately. Make two strips. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
8. Sew together four 4¹/₂" CM6590 Pacific squares and three pieced squares alternately. Noting the strip orientation of the strip, sew a Corner Block to each end. Make two strips. Sew one to the top and the other to the bottom of the quilt top.
9. Sew together five 2¹/₂" x WOF Shimmer-Ocean strips end to end. Measure the quilt center length and cut two strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.
10. Measure the quilt center width and cut two Shimmer-Ocean strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt.

Finishing

11. Layer the quilt top, batting and backing, and quilt as desired.
12. Stitch the binding strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Fold and press the resulting long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together. Stitch to the quilt front, matching raw edges and mitering the corners.
13. Fold the binding to the quilt underside and hand-stitch the folded edge to the quilt back.
